There are lots of opportunities to expand your knowledge and get a college education while still in high school!

- **Introduction to College & Careers at CCV** - Free to all students starting their sophomore year. This course is designed to help students navigate their path to college. Even if students are unsure if they want to pursue a college degree this is a great course to take. ICC is not college credit bearing but some high schools will award credit for successful completion of the course.
- **Foundational level English & Math courses at CCV** - These courses help students build the foundational English and Math knowledge needed to be successful at the college level. These courses are not college credit bearing but some high schools will award credit for successful completion of the course. They are often free courtesy of VSAC.
- **Dual Enrollment** - All VT students have the option to take two college classes of their choosing at a participating Vermont college or university for free before graduating (Jr & Sr only)
- **Fast Forward (Concurrent Enrollment)**- students who are enrolled in a technical high school have 2 additional vouchers to take college classes that are offered on site at their technical center. We offer a wide array of these courses at CTE. Most of which are offered in the fall are for returning students only. More options will be available for the spring semester. (CTE Offerings on other side)

These are college level courses so students need to be ready to pursue college level studies. In order to assess a student's readiness most of the available options listed above (except for Introduction to College & Careers) require that students take the Accuplacer or WorkKeys placement exam which can be taken right here at CTE.
