My Child is in a class with a student

who has a life threatening food allergy...now what?

An estimated 4 - 6 % of children in the United States have food allergies. EES is an Allergy Aware School. All of the food served in the cafeteria is nut free. Foods that contain, may contain, or are processed in a facility that produces foods that students are allergic to are not allowed in their classrooms. We educate children about the safety of not sharing food. We educate Staff and students about what to do if an allergic reaction does occur. We keep EPI-PENS on hand for emergency treatment. My web page has information on how to read labels. What can you do as a parent? You can send in allergy free / labeled snacks for your child. You can talk to your child about not sharing food. If your child has a Birthday and you want to celebrate in class...Non food celebrations are preferred. Store bought, allergen free snacks with a label must be checked by the Nurse prior to going to the classroom.
